**February 1, 2020 - Swimming Competition – Boys 9:00 A.M., Girls 2:00 P.M.**
- Eligibility:** All 6, 7 & 8th graders who meet the minimum event requirements and Participate in **2 middle school swim meets are eligible.**  
**Coaches: You will need to provide an eligibility letter with your entry. All Competing Swimmers and divers must be listed on the form. Use the standard MHSAA sport eligibility form. This letter must be signed by the MS/JH Athletic director or Principal. The form is available at the MHSAA website**
- All times and scores must be achieved during the 2019-20 season in a middle school / junior high competition!*
- YOU MUST BE A MISCA MEMBER TO ENTER YOUR ATHLETES IN THE MEET. WE WILL BE CHECKING EVERYONES MEMBERSHIP IN ORDER TO GET ONTO THE POOL DECK THIS YEAR. This includes assistant coaches and diving coaches.***
- Register on-line before the meet - Fee is \$45.00 Coaches can register at the meet for \$60.00. Register at [www.miscaonline.net](http://www.miscaonline.net)
- Time Schedule:** **Friday January 31, 2020 4:00- 5:55 pm Diving Warm – up**  
**Friday January 31, 2020: 6:00 pm Diving Competition begins.**  
**Saturday February 1, 2020: 8:00 am – 8:55 am Boys Swimming Warm –up**  
**Saturday February 1, 2020: 9:00 am Boys Swimming Meet Starts**  
**Saturday February 1, 2020: 1:00pm-1:55pm Girls Swimming Warm – up**  
**Saturday February 1, 2020: 2:00 pm Girls Swimming meet Starts.**
- Format:** **Swimming Format:** This year we will be allowing every swimmer who achieves the cutoff time to swim at the meet. Each school is still only allowed to enter 1 relay team per relay event. Each athlete may be entered in a maximum of 4 events, not more than 2 of which may be individual events.
- DIVING FORMAT:** The top 24 divers (24 boys and 24 girls) will do 6 dives. National Federation Rule 9 Sec. 4 Art 6. The required dive is your option (1.8 DD Max), and then must have 4 out of 5 categories represented after the required dive.
- Awards:** Medals will be given for 1st through 8th place finishes. - No team scores will be kept. Medals will be presented after the end of the next event.

## Diving Entry:

**This is a 6 Dive meet and only scores from 6 dive meets will be accepted. See the Diving Entry procedure below on how to enter your divers.**

**You are not allowed to use and composite or extrapolated scores to achieve a 6 dive total.** It is recommended that if you dive in a league with less than 6 dives that you do exhibition rounds to make up the difference and get a score for entry to the meet.

## Diving Entry Procedure:

### **New For 2018**

1. Enter the Diver in Diving in your team Manager entry For your team.
2. Email the entry chair at [coachdtr1@gmail.com](mailto:coachdtr1@gmail.com) with the following information
  - a. Divers Name
  - b. Score #1 with Meet Name and Date
  - c. Score #2 with Meet Name and Date
3. Goto Cleanentries.com to enter your diver(s) and dive Sheet(s)
4. After the deadline we will determine the top 24 for each gender and will post it on the MISCA Site by the time mentioned below.
5. Bring your two diving sheets to the meet with you in case your score is challenged.

We will have diving sheets for you to sign when you get to the meet on Friday, changes can be made until 5:30 pm Friday evening.

## Entry Procedure:

**Please use the provided event file available from the MISCA website to prepare your entries.** The entry procedure will be the same as for the High School MISCA meets and State Championship meets. Entries must be submitted by using Hy-Tek's Team Manager or Team Manager Lite, or compatible meet management software. Import the meet file into your Team Manager program. **All entries are due by Sunday January 26, 2020 at 11:59 pm by email.** If you do not have Team Manager go to [www.hy-tek.com/downloads.html](http://www.hy-tek.com/downloads.html) to obtain a copy of Team Manager Lite to use for your entries.

### **Additionally**

1. Grade years must be included with your swimmers. (See doc on MISCA Website for how to do this)
2. You must use the Team Abbreviation listed on the MISCA Website.
3. If you do not your entry will be returned for you to redo.

**No Entries will be accepted unless in hy-tek or similar compatible format. Make sure to include your divers in your entry**

**Email your entries to coachdtr1@gmail.com**

Our goal is to send an email confirmation by the end of the day on January 28 to let you know that your entries were received. **You have until Tuesday January 28 by the end of the day to make any corrections to your entry, If you do not respond we will assume that everything is correct.**

If you do not receive a verification email by Tuesday at 8 am contact the meet manager at the phone number or email address above. (Make sure to check your junk mail box before you call)

If you do not respond to the verification email, you waive the right to make any changes in your line-up. **By Wednesday evening January 29, a psych sheet will be posted on the MISCA website: [www.miscaonline.net](http://www.miscaonline.net).** This will allow you to check and see if your divers have qualified for the meet.

**NO CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE PSYCH SHEET HAS BEEN POSTED!**

**Entry Fees:** A fee of \$5.00 per individual event and \$12.00 per relay will be charged. **Checks should be made out to MISCA.** Fees are due upon arrival at the meet. Schools will be assessed meet fees for failure to show up **AFTER** confirmation of entries.

**Spectators:** \$5 per person, Heat sheets \$2. There is no Food or Drink allowed in the stands or on the pool deck. The spectator area fills quickly but please be patient we have been able to accommodate almost everyone who wants to watch the last several years. **Please No seat backs in the spectator area as they take up extra seats.**

**IF YOU ARE NOT A MISCA MEMBER, GO TO THE WEBSITE AND FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS ON THE WEBSITE TO SIGN UP ONLINE. ON DECK MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE MEET FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$15 FEE.**

**IF YOU ARE NOT A MISCA MEMBER YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. WE WILL BE CHECKING EVERY COACHES MEMBERSHIP AND ISSUING DECK PASSES.**

**Directions:** From Grand Rapids: 96 East to Lansing exit 101 M L King Blvd. Right at light to Bishop Rd. left on Bishop to stop sign Grovenburg Rd. turn right follow Grovenburg Rd. to Holt Rd. turn left at stop light High School will be building on your right turn right at light pool entrance is on the east side of the building.

From Jackson: US 127 north to Holt Rd. exit turn left follow Holt Rd. West to 6th stop light turn left pool entrance is on East side of building.

From Flint : I 69 to Lansing to US 127 S. to Holt Rd. exit turn right go to 6th stop light turn left pool entrance is on East side of building.

From Detroit: 96 West to Lansing exit 101 MLK Blvd. Turn Left (south) to bishop Rd  
Turn Left on Bishop to stop sign at Grovenburg Rd. Turn Right follow Grovenburg Rd. to  
Holt Rd. turn left at stop light High School will be building on your right turn right at light  
pool entrance is on the east side of the building.
