

M.I.S.C.A. Academic All-State Team Award: Guidelines for Applications 2018-2019

Girls and Boys application deadline is the last Friday in March.

No late entries will be accepted after March 29.

There is an online application this year so please use that one if possible!

Also, you must be a current MISCA member in order to submit your application!

Directions:

1. Athletes must have participated and finished the season in good standing to be eligible.
2. Cumulative GPA is to be used including the last full semester in which credit was earned.
3. Round GPA to the nearest hundredth
4. Recorded scores may not be higher than 4.0. GPA higher than 4.0 reverts to 4.0.
5. The application is to list the entire varsity team and average the GPA for each of these individuals to determine the team GPA. You must have a minimum of 10 athletes to apply for the MISCA Academic All-State Team Award.
6. Use 90% of team members to calculate your team GPA.
7. If the program cannot field a complete team, it may not apply.
8. By sending an application, you are verifying its authenticity.
9. A complete list of team winners will be posted on the M.I.S.C.A. website.
10. The top 10 teams will receive certificates

Step One

-List all varsity athletes. The required minimum number is 10 per team.

Step Two

-List the varsity team athletes by name, grade, and cumulative grade point average. Round to the nearest hundredth. Use 90% of the team's athletes to find the team's GPA. (For example, if your team has 20 athletes, use 18 athletes to find a total)

Step Three:

-Add up 90% of the grade point averages to find the total.

Step Four:

-Divide the total by the number of members used to determine the TEAM COMPOSITE GRADE POINT AVERAGE. Round to the nearest hundredth. This average is used to determine if your team qualifies for the M.I.S.C.A. Academic All State Team Award. This average must rank in the top ten to be All State in each division.

Step Five:

-Email MISCA All-State Team Award application to kstumpf@jpsonline.org. He will send an email back verifying reception of the application. He will also email if there are any issues with the application.

Signatures & Acceptance of Terms:

Signatures are no longer required. Coaches will type their name, title, and school name which will serve as an electronic signature. Only official members of a school staff are allowed to submit applications. All coaches must be MISCA members in order to apply.
