Visiting Team

- The visiting team is asked to arrive between 4:45 PM and 5:00 PM
- The visiting coach will conduct COVID-19 check in and temperature check either upon or prior to team arrival
- The visiting team will set in the bleachers and chairs on the South (and Southeast) side of the pool deck; 6-foot intervals are marked with a Blue X
- Visitors are always expected to be in their seats except when in the water
- Visitors will warmup and compete in lanes 6, 7, and 8
- Divers will warmup on the board over lanes 4 & 5
- Only divers are allowed in lanes 4 & 5
- When not on the board, diver will wear a mask and stay 6-feet away from others
- No changing (locker) facilities are to be used on premise
- The bathroom in the boy's locker room may be used by visiting team members limited to 1 person in the locker room at a time
- A team roster will be sent to the host school the day before the competition
- The roster will include coaches' names, captains' names, student names and grades
- A list of spectators will be sent to the host school the day before the competition; the list will include the team member name and the full names of their 2 spectators

Host Team

- The host team will arrive between 4:15 PM and 4:30 PM
- The host coach will confirm COVID-19 check in and temperature check upon arrival. (See MHSAA Form)
- The host team will set in the bleachers and chairs on the North (and Northeast) side of the pool deck; 6-foot intervals are marked with a Blue X
- Host team members are always expected to be in their seats except when in the water
- Host team members will warmup and compete in lanes 1, 2, and 3
- Divers will warmup on the board over lanes 4 & 5
- Only divers are allowed in lanes 4 & 5
- When not on the board, diver will wear a mask and stay 6-feet away from others
- When not in the water, swimmers will wear a mask and stay 6-feet away from others
- No changing (locker) facilities are to be used on premise.
- The bathroom in the girls' locker room may be used by host team members limited to 1 person in the locker room at a time
- A team roster will be sent to the host school the day before the competition
- The roster will include coaches' names, captains' names, student names and grades
- A list of spectators will be sent to the host school the day before the competition; the list will include the team member name and the full names of their 2 spectators

Both Teams

- A radio will be provided for each team to communicate with officials and the office
- Only 1 swimmer at a time may be behind a starting block in each lane; swimmers that are behind the starting block must be within 2 feet of the block
- Swimmers should enter the pool at the starting end; one at a time in each lane (see above)
- Only 1 swimmer at a time may be on-deck at the shallow end of each lane (i.e. counting for the 500 only)
- All participants must stay behind the blue line; the area on the other side of the blue line is reserved for officials
- Coaches, managers, and other team personnel must stay in their team area; Coaches may go to the office door to turn in entries, to correct entries, and to pick up results
- All team members should store their personal items in their assigned area

Spectators

- Spectators will arrive between 5:15 PM and 5:45 PM
- Spectators will show a picture ID and must be on the list submitted by the teams
- Admission is \$5.00 for everyone; please have exact amount
- CAAC & Family Passes are accepted, but those individuals must be on the spectator list submitted by the teams
- No student / staff ID passes accepted
- Spectators must wear a mask at all times
- Spectators who do not reside in the same household must practice physical distancing of 6-feet

Streaming

- If the meet will be live streamed the information to view the stream will be provided to both visitors and host

Meet Workers

- A list of meet workers will be provided by the host coach to the athletic department the morning of the meet
- All meet workers must wear a mask and stay 6-feet away from others
- Essential Personnel include Office Staff (announcer, scoring computer operator, timer operator, etc.) and Timers
 - Office Staff are asked to arrive between 5:00 PM and 5:15 PM
 - Office Staff should go directly to the office & should stay in the office
 - Timers are asked to arrive between 5:30 PM and 5:45 PM
 - Timers should go directly to the chair at the shallow end of the pool until diving is over
 - When diving is complete, Timers should go to the chair against the wall behind their assigned lane
 - Timers should stay at their chair except at the finish of each race
 - The Head Time should stay in the area just outside of the office except when collecting Timers' card
- Meet workers must stay in their designated area
- Meet workers should store their personal items in their designated area

Officials

- Officials are asked to arrive between 5:00 PM and 5:30 PM
- A chair will be provided on each side of the pool for the officials' use
- The official is asked to stay on their side of the blue line during competition
- A radio will be available for officials to use to communicate with each other, the coaches, and the office
- Officials should store their personal items on or under their chair

Entries

- The host team will have their entries loaded into the scoring computer before the visiting team arrives
- The visiting team will provide electronically loadable entries on a flash drive when they arrive
- Changes to entries will be made in writing and delivered to the office no later than the finish of the previous event

Order and Flow of Events (Diving will be held as the first event to reduce the number of pool configuration)

For diving:

- During warm-up, diving board will close at 5:45 pm to provide extra time for set-up; one diving board will be available for warm up and competition
- Diving will take place at the start of the meet as the first event to minimize extra moving of lane lanes, etc.
- Visiting team should provide host team with a list of divers who will be competing prior to the meet, in the preferred order of competition
- During warm-up and during the competition, the visiting team divers will exit the pool and wait in line for the board on the visitor-side of the pool (closest to the spectator bleachers); there will be numbered markers on the wall behind the diving boards where divers will stand and remain physically distanced while waiting for their turn
- Hooks will be available on the railing on both sides of the diving board for divers to hang their masks and shammies temporarily while taking their turn
- Dive sheets for the entire team should be completed, signed by divers and coach, and turned in all together in the preferred competition order to the designated official by 5:30 pm; we encourage any dive changes be worked out prior to dive sheets being turned in to minimize extra handling of dive sheets
- During the competition, the home judge and one official will sit on the home side of the pool, and the visiting judge and one official will sit on the visitor side of the pool; officials will have radios to confer with each other and their judge across the pool, and with meet workers in the office.
- The official and judge on each side of the pool will be sitting 6-feet apart to maintain physical distance; physical scorecards will be used for judging and will be disinfected before and after the competition by the home diving coach

For individual swimming events:

- When the last swimmer in the previous event/heat has left the starting block, and not before, the timer in that lane will leave their seat and move beside the block to time their lane; once they have the finish time the timer will return to their seat against the wall and record their time
- When all timers have recorded times, the Head Timer will collect the timer cards and deliver them to the office
- When the Head Timer has delivered the timer cards to the office, and not before, the swimmer in the next heat/event should move from their seat to behind the block in their assigned lane

For relay events:

- Only the first swimmer in each lane will be behind the block in each lane
- When a relay swimmer leaves the block, and not before, the next relay swimmer in that lane should move from their seat to behind the block in their assigned lane
- When a relay swimmer finishes their leg of the race they must climb out and immediately return to their seat and put on their mask
- When the last relay swimmer leaves the starting block, and not before, the timer in that lane will leave their seat and move beside the block to time their lane; once they have the finish time the timer will return to their seat against the wall and record their time
- When all timers have recorded times, the Head Timer will collect the timer cards and deliver them to the office
- When the Head Timer has delivered the timer cards to the office, and not before, the swimmer in the next heat/event should move from their seat to behind the block in their assigned lane

Other Items

- Only Office Staff are allowed in the office
- Only the announcer and camera operator (if streaming) are allowed in the crowd's nest

General Timeline

4:45 PM – 5:00 PM	Visiting team arrives (please go directly to seating provide)
5:00 PM	Pool is open for warm-up (if setup is complete warm-up may start earlier)
5:00 PM – 5:15 PM	Office workers arrive (please go directly to the office)
5:00 PM - 5:30 PM	Officials arrive (please store belonging under the chair provided)
5:15 PM – 5:45 PM	Spectators arrive.
5:30 PM – 5:45 PM	Timers arrive (go to chairs at shallow end for diving)
5:45 PM	Warm-up is complete
5:50 PM	Introduce Seniors and their parents Senior Night Presentation (for Senior Night Only)
6:05 PM	Team introductions and National Anthem
6:10 PM	Diving begins
